

## **2-year postdoctoral position in equine virology**

The Frank Duncombe Laboratory (FDL) has an immediate vacancy for a postdoctoral fellow to join the current team composed of 5 vets (incl. 3 PhD), 3 biologists (incl. 2 PhD) and technical staff. Our team is attached to IFR 146 of Caen University (Normandy, Calvados).

The diagnostic team dedicated to horse biology is composed of about 40 persons including administrative staff.

The successful candidate will be PhD graduate (DVM or not). He / she will primarily work on equid herpesviruses (mainly EHV-1 and EHV-2) within the Research & Development Unit of FDL, in close collaboration with two Institutes in Germany and Belgium. The grant dedicated to this position is about 2000 euro (tax-free) per month, with opportunity for low-cost accommodation on the University campus (tramway for center town)

Good experience in molecular biology, qRT-PCR and phylogeny is a prerequisite, whereas French speaking is not. Previous knowledge about clinical virology will be an advantage. Horse manipulation will not be required for this position but appreciated.
