Applications are invited from veterinary graduates to undertake a three-year residency programme in either Anatomic or Clinical Pathology. The successful candidates will be based at the Hawkshead campus of the Royal Veterinary College. Scholars are enrolled for the College's Masters in Veterinary Medicine (MVetMed) degree and have the opportunity to undertake a research project. The Royal Veterinary College has a large pathology team including five Anatomic Pathologists, three Clinical Pathologists and ten current residents in either Clinical or Anatomic Pathology.

The co-funded RVC-AHVLA Fellowship focusses the candidate on farm animal pathology while receiving a broad exposure to the other veterinary species, high disease containment facilities and modern pathology research tools. Based at the Royal Veterinary College and at AHVLA Weybridge, the Fellow will spend 75% of their time developing Pathology capability, and 25% on research activities. There may also be opportunities to obtain a greater understanding of disease surveillance and investigation with placement at other AHVLA locations.

Completion of the programme meets the eligibility requirements for the Board examinations of the American College of Veterinary Pathologists (DipACVP) and the Fellowship examinations of the Royal College of Pathologists (FRCPath).
