Resident in Veterinary Clinical Pathology

In Vitro Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory in Vienna, Austria invites applications for a 4-year (alternative programme) residency in Veterinary Clinical Pathology.

The residency programme follows the guidelines of the European College of Veterinary Clinical Pathology (ECVCP) at an ECVCP-approved training laboratory. Its purpose is to provide the resident with a comprehensive educational experience in thorough diagnostic service responsibilities, practical work with the analysers, and participation in weekly rounds as well as presentations at the annual ESVCP meeting.

Required qualifications for the candidate include:

- A DVM or equivalent degree
- A one-year rotating internship or an equivalent practical experience
- A strong interest in clinical pathology including pathophysiology, chemistry and statistics
- Very good language skills in German and English

The successful applicant will work with an ECVCP board-certified veterinary clinical pathologist as supervisor, a second-year resident and three specialists in veterinary clinical pathology.

The anticipated start date of the residency is 1st October, 2010. Applications will be accepted until the position is filled. Candidate selection is based on strength of curriculum vitae, level and quality of experience and commitment to a career in veterinary clinical pathology.

Applications should include curriculum vitae inclusive of a synopsis of educational background, employment experience, and statement of professional goals and a list of three references (name, address, phone number, e-mail address). Application documents should be submitted preferably by email to:
